Here's how it works: lurking beneath the easy-off leak-proof threaded Gamma-Seal lid (great for mobile detailers or show competitors) is a patented **Grit Guard™** cleaning insert positioned atop four spring-loaded mechanical water pumps. Pushing the **Grit Guard™ Insert** downward with the buffer pumps jets of clean water upward into the pad, vigorously flushing away embedded grit, oxidized paint and used polishing compounds. These abrasive contaminants settle and become trapped below the pump support base, where they can no longer damage your paint. There's also high-speed pumping and flushing action as the spinning pad rubs its fibers and pores against the ribs of the **Grit Guard™ Insert**, rapidly alternating between being rung out and absorbing fresh water. And the **Universal Pad Washer** isn't just a pad cleaner; it converts into the classic **Grit Guard™ Washing System** just by removing the pump assembly, so the **UPW** is really two car care products in one.
